



1. REQUIRING AGENCY AND CONTRACTING OFFICE:

2. NATURE/DESCRIPTION OF ACTION(S): This justification for other than full and open competition will result in an award of a firm fixed price delivery order for brand name Good for Enterprise client licenses (CAL's).

3. DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES/SERVICES: A complete description of the supplies and/or services required to meet the agency's need, including the delivery schedule and/or the period of performance (inclusive of all options), and the estimated life-cycle cost of the procurement. 4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY: 10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1) as implemented by FAR Part 6.302-1(c). Application of Brand Name Descriptions

5. DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS: The Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA) manages commissary operations worldwide for the Defense Department. This includes the headquarters, region offices, and approximately 250 commissaries worldwide. The agency currently uses Good Mobile Message Server with 50 Good for Enterprise (GFE) client access licenses (CALs) to manage Government Furnished Mobile devices and the "Bring Your Own Device" (BYOD) utilized under DeCA's fiscal year 2012 pilot program. Good server and client applications meet security configuration requirements in accordance with Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) security and technical implantation guidelines (STIGs) for non-enterprise activated commercial mobile devices (http://iase.disa.mil/stigs/net_perimeter/wireless/smartphone.html) and after rigorous evaluation the program was granted an Interim Authority to Test (IATT) accreditation standing. Significant cost savings were identified during the pilot phase by allowing the use of personally owned devices for communication as the agency was able to reduce the use of Government furnished mobile devices. The BYOD program has been approved o move from pilot phase to implementation phase. As

software publishers, Good Technologies software is proprietary; therefore, only Good GFE CALs are capable of accessing the existing Good Server. Movement into the implementation phase requires the procurement of an additional 50 CALs. These products do not impact any other applications in the agency.

6. FEDBIZOPPS ANNOUNCEMENT/POTENTIAL SOURCES: In accordance with FAR Part 5.202(a) 11 and 13(i), this requirement will be posted with the issuance of the solicitation on the respective agency's website.

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: In accordance with FAR 8.404, 12.209, 13.106-1(2), and 14.408-2, I hereby determine that the anticipated cost or price to the Government for this contract action will be fair and reasonable. The price reasonableness memorandum detailing the Fair and Reasonable Price Determination will be included in the contract file documentation.

8. MARKET RESEARCH: In accordance with DFARS 208.74, Use of Enterprise Software Agreements (ESA), market research was conducted through the ARMY CHESS website. This research indicates that the licenses are not available on an existing ESA agreement. As such, additional market research was conducted utilizing the system for award management's Central Contractor Registration (CCR) site, the NASA SEWP (SEWP), and GSA Advantage websites. This research indicates that these licenses are available through both SEWP and GSA. Government Wide Acquisition Contracts (GWAC), are one of the preferred sources of supply for Commercial Information Technology products and services. Additionally, DeCA has successfully solicited and awarded competitive acquisition buys through SEWP IV contract vehicles.

9. ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS: By expanding the license base and authorizing additional participants to utilize the BYOD program, the agency expects to realize additional cost savings by further reducing the use of Government furnished mobile devices.

10. LISTING OF INTERESTED SOURCES: DeCA has identified several resellers on the SEWP website that have the capability of fulfilling this requirement.

11. ACTIONS TAKEN TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION: DeCA continues perform market research for products that are available and designed to implement mobile security controls to protect sensitive information and address regulatory requirements for government data over-the-air and at rest on devices. DeCA continually communicates and works with other DoD agencies, its business partners, and attends trade and industry shows, in an effort to stay abreast of this evolving technology. As legislation and regulatory changes mandated by DoD change and influence the DoD department's information technology requirements, the commercial market place's ability to stay abreast of those changes and provide viable solutions will also change.
