General Services Administration Federal Supply Schedule

This acquisition is being conducted under the authority of Section 201 of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 (40 U.S.C.501) Multiple Award Schedule Program FAR 8.401 and is justified by the following facts and rationale required under FAR 8.405-6(b)(1), brand name specifications as follows:

- (1) Requiring Agency and Contracting Activity:

Contracting Activity: Store Services Support Division, IT Procurement Branch

Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA), Store Services Support Division, IT Procurement Branch proposes to enter into a contract on a basis of other than full and open competition.

(2) Nature/Description of Action(s): The Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA) has a requirement on a limited source basis to procure brand name Metasploit software and maintenance support.

(3) Description of Supplies/services. HQCAAA-3065-2100
Purchase Metasploit Pro Software and its maintenance support. The software will be used to conduct computer forensic investigations, penetration testing, exploit verification, social engineering tests and Intrusion Detection System (IDS) signature development.

(4) Identification of the Justification and Rationale. Department of Defense (DoD) agencies are mandated, in accordance with DoD directive (DoDD) 8530 and DoD Instruction 8500, to conduct computer forensic investigations, penetration testing, exploit verification, social

engineering tests and IDS signature development to discover, access, integrate, correlate and fuse data/information that supports the agency's mission objectives and minimizes vulnerabilities across the enterprise as they apply to the implementation of the DoD security requirements and information assurance implementation. All DoD information systems must comply with the DoD Information Assurance Certification and Accreditation Process (CIACAP). Metasploit-Pro is a software based Computer Network Defense (CND) security tool used for penetration testing, risk validation, network asset discovery, web application scanning, password auditing, and social engineering simulation testing.

Metasploit Pro helps enterprise defenders prevent data breaches by efficiently prioritizing vulnerabilities, verifying controls and mitigation strategies, and conducting real-world, collaborative, broad-scope penetration tests to improve your security risk intelligence. The product being requested replaces DeCA's existing application whereby DeCA will realize a cost savings and have more capabilities under the new software application. Use of this software will ensure that the agency meets the requirements of DIACAP and minimizes vulnerabilities to the network and the DoD. This assures compliance of Interconnections of Intelligence Community (IC) systems and DoD systems accomplished using a process jointly agreed on by the DoD CIO and the Associate Director of National Intelligence (ADNI) and CIO principal accrediting authority.

(5) FEDBIZOPPS (FBO) announcement/potential sources. In accordance with FAR part 8.405-6(3)(i) limited sources, DeCA will solicit the three (3) known GSA resellers of Metasploit Pro. In accordance with the requirements of the above authority, this LSJ will also be posted to the GSA eBuy in an effort to bolster competition.

(6) Determination by the Ordering Activity Contracting Officer that the anticipated order represents the best value consistent with 8.404(d). The Contracting Officer has determined that issuing the proposed Delivery Order against an existing GSA schedule represents the best value to the Government. This order will be placed in accordance with FAR 8.404 – Use of Federal Supply Schedules. GSA has already negotiated fair and reasonable pricing. The acceptable inflation factor for this commodity in the commercial market place is 10% annually; thus the government can expect to defer an increase in out-year costs.

(7) Market Research. Market research was conducted through searches of the Internet and trade publications, information technology and security articles, trade show and conferences attendance, and surveys of other Department of Defense agencies. It was concluded that Metasploit Pro provides the required capabilities at a lower cost than DeCA's current application.

In accordance with the mandate of DFARS 208-74, market research was conducted through the ARMY CHESS (CHESS) Enterprise Software Agreements (ESA) site. This research indicates that the product and maintenance support is not available through an existing ESA agreement. Additional market research was conducted through the GSA Advantage site which indicates that there are at least three (3) vendors on GSA that have the capability to fulfill this requirement. Since the product being procured will be used to conduct computer forensic investigations, penetration testing, exploit verification, social engineering tests and Intrusion

Detection System (IDS) signature development, DeCA will utilize the GSA venue as it has successfully solicited and awarded its primary network anomaly based intrusion detection and analysis based hardware appliances and maintenance support through this vehicle.

(8) Any Other Facts to Support the Justification. It was concluded that Metasploit Pro provides the required capabilities at a lower cost than the product DeCA is currently using.

(9) Actions Taken to Remove Barriers to Competition. While DeCA is soliciting an awarding this as a brand name limited sources justification, the agency has identified and does expect to obtain pricing from at least three GSA resellers.

(10) Contracting Officer's Certification. In accordance with FAR 8.405-6(g)(2)(ix), I certify that the data supporting the recommended use of other than full and open competition is accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
