



## DIRECTOR'S POLICY 500-36

# VENDOR DEMONSTRATION, PRESENTATION, LOAN AND TESTING OF SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES (EXCLUDING COMMISSARY RESALE PRODUCT)

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**1. PURPOSE.** This DP implements policy, assigns responsibilities, and provides guidance and procedures for vendor demonstrations, presentations, loan, and testing of supplies, equipment, or services (excluding commissary resale products) for DeCA.

## **2. POLICY.**

a. All DeCA personnel shall use DeCA Form (DeCAF) 10-8, "Statement of Vendor Understanding," Enclosure 1 to facilitate vendor demonstration, presentation, loan, or testing of equipment, supplies, or services for marketing purposes to the government. Participants shall take precautionary measures to avoid incurring unauthorized costs or liability as a result of such activities.

b. Whether initiated by the government or vendor, this policy applies to all proceedings excluding the following:

(1) Commissary subsistence/resale products; and

(2) Advertisements, descriptive literature, samples, parts manuals, price lists, or other publications or materials available at no cost from commercial firms.

### **3. RESPONSIBILITIES.**

a. Government Coordinator. Prior to the scheduled vendor demonstration, presentation, loan, and testing of supplies, equipment or services (excluding commissary resale products), the government event coordinator shall ensure:

(1) The government shall not incur any cost or liability associated with vendor demonstrations, presentations, loans, or testing of supplies, equipment, or services:

(2) Participating vendors complete Enclosure 1. The original completed form shall remain on file with the initiating activity and a copy shall be forwarded to the supporting contracting office for retention and official documentation of the event; and

(3) Contact the contracting officer concerning what information can or cannot be released to commercial firms during proceedings. Activities are strongly advised that any commitment made on behalf of the Government can only be approved in writing by a warranted contracting officer pursuant to Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 1.602.

b. Participants shall refrain from releasing information concerning Government requirements and/or proposed procurements to any commercial firms.

### **4. PROCEDURES.**

a. Prior to the scheduled vendor demonstration, presentation, loan, and testing of supplies, equipment, or services (excluding commissary resale products), the Government event coordinator shall provide the vendor a copy of Enclosure 1 for completion.


b. Once the vendor completes and returns DeCAF 10-8, the Government event coordinator shall forward a copy to the supporting contracting office for retention and official documentation of the event. The Government event coordinator shall keep the original DeCAF 10-8 on file as part of the originating activity's official records.

c. The Government event coordinator and participants shall contact the contracting officer concerning what information can or cannot be released to commercial firms during proceedings.

Activities are strongly advised that any commitment made on behalf of the government can only be approved in writing by a warranted contracting officer pursuant to FAR 1.602.

d. At the end of the vendor demonstration, presentation, loan, and testing of supplies or equipment, the supplies and equipment shall be returned to the vendor at the expense of the vendor. Samples not usable as end items, such as carpet squares, cut paneling, etc., may be regarded as advertising or reference material, and as such, retained by the Government as deemed appropriate. Where samples are consumed or their usefulness is impaired by tests, they will be disposed of as scrap unless the vendor requests their return. Products and samples shall not be accepted by Government personnel or Government contractors for use or disposition except on a loan basis as covered by Enclosure 1.


**5. APPLICABILITY.** This DP assigns responsibility for accomplishing the requirements of DoD Publications program, in accordance with DoDI 5025.01. This DP applies to all DeCA activities and all DeCA personnel.
